

# Broadband arrives in Lyme

**LYME** — Residents of Lyme now have access to high-speed Internet access through FINOWEN (Fast InterNet on Wireless EtherNet), according to Director of Marketing Tessa Johnson.

“We had people that were clamoring at our door for months and months,” Johnson said. In a press release she writes that the response to the new service has been “overwhelming.”

According to the release, “high-speed Internet access

was noticeably lacking in Lyme ... We are pleased to be able to offer such a valuable service to the residents of Lyme and neighboring communities.”

FINOWEN service works through a small antenna attached to the customer's house. The antenna creates a wireless link to the Internet. “With relatively low infrastructure costs ... FINOWEN is able to bring broadband to rural New Hampshire and Vermont,” the release states.
